County Borough Council

- a. Flooding in Llanspyddid – Cllr. Hill has spoken to Simon Crowther who said that engineers are coming to speak to residents, money is being provided by the Welsh Assembly for the work.
- b. Speeding issues in Libanus, Llanspyddid and Llanhamlach – nothing to report in Libanus and Llanspyddid but Llanhamlach have been successful in reducing the speed limit.
- c. There has been a big u-turn in Powys regarding secondary education. Welsh medium education is back on the agenda. A lot of money has been wasted on consultations.
- d. A dog mess bin is needed at Libanus playground – Cllr. Fitzpatrick to speak to Powys CC
- e. A refuse bin is needed at the bus stops in Libanus – Cllr. Fitzpatrick to speak to Powys CC
- f. There has been a massive overspend in adult social care, money has been wasted on consultants.
- g. Recycling – there has been an increase in fly tipping. All recycling centres are being closed apart from Brecon.
- h. There has been an increase in burglaries in car parks and houses in the area.
